One of the most important routine maintenance tasks is changing the oil and filter. "Mahindra recommends a specific oil and filter you should use to get the best performance and longest life from your tractor," explained Mahindra USA National Service Manager Charles Huff. "Mahindra puts a lot of time and resources into researching which oils (including additives) and filters will work best with your engine and applications. It can be counter productive over the long haul to skimp on these essential maintenance items," added Huff. "The pennies

you might save by buying a cheaper oil could end up costing you a lot if that oil doesn't hold up to the high loads or dusty conditions you subject your tractor to."

Your hydraulic system should be regularly checked, too. "Microscopic particles in the hydraulic fluid can contaminate the oil and cause it to fail. Air in the system can result in damage to components, causing loss of lubrication and overheating. Water in the system can result in corrosion," said Huff.

The cooling system also needs routine maintenance. Checking the level of antifreeze is important, but it's not the whole job. We can make sure the additives in the coolant have not been depleted. If the additives are gone, electrolysis could be corroding the metal in your cooling system.

As routine service is performed, we will also check for leaking seals, make sure the belts and hoses are in good condition, and check other systems. We are also able to identify and fix any warranty issues that arise in the course of the inspection.
